



One week left to have your say on Light Rail for Auckland.

Feedback closes next Tuesday 31 August.

With our ambitious engagement programme drawing to an end, the project team have turned the focus to online channels for the final week of engagement during lockdown.

“We want to really encourage people to give their feedback by participating online during this final week,” says Auckland Light Rail Project Director Tommy Parker.

“It’s important people take this opportunity to participate and share their views in this process,” says Parker. “During lockdown, our project team are happy to chat on the phone or reply to email queries.”

Opportunities to participate online are being boosted through social media, while new information and resources are being constantly added to the project website.

“We want to provide Aucklanders with a good understanding of the project so they can have informed conversations about what it will mean for their communities and for the wider city.”

There is a huge amount of interest in Auckland Light Rail, with over 1100 online surveys completed. Since June we’ve delivered over 60 stakeholder briefings, workshops and community events.

The feedback reflects a growing understanding of the potential for urban, community and economic outcomes from light rail. We’re also listening to concerns to make sure we are able to consider and address these in the early planning stage.
