Auckland Light Rail work accelerates with new company

Auckland Light Rail Ltd (ALR Ltd) has now been established as a Crown Entity Company to deliver what will become New Zealand's largest transport infrastructure project and completely change the way Aucklanders can travel around the city.

ALR Ltd's establishment coincides with the recent announcement of a team of preferred bidders made up of New Zealand and international experts to work with ALR Ltd on the planning and design phase. This is an important step; New Zealand's never tackled a project of this scale before and it's great to now have the experts we need on board and underway.
