





What is light rail?



Light rail has been identified by the Government as a key transport priority in Auckland. At the end of the year an announcement will be made by the Government about the mode, route and delivery (what, where and made by who).

As well as providing a much-needed alternative for Auckland commuters, light rail will generate new opportunities for families and communities. But the ones who will benefit the most are our future generations.

Light rail is a system using small trains or trams.

What does the future of your neighbourhood with light rail look like?


Before they put pen (or pencil or crayon or paint) to paper, we recommend having a kōrero with students about what they could be depicting.
