

Transforming neighbourhoods

Light Rail is the next big step in expanding Auckland's rapid transit network and building a high capacity, linked up system across the city

By improving transport choices, we can make Tāmaki Makaurau a better place to live now and in the future.

Auckland Light Rail is our chance to reshape our neighbourhoods to work better for us and change how our city grows. It will connect people to work and study and enable new homes in growing communities, helping to reduce sprawl. It will also mean we won't have to rely on cars, and this will reduce emissions.

Light Rail will start with light rail from the City Centre to Māngere and eventually connect to the North Shore and North West. Planning is already underway on the Waitematā Harbour Connections project to look at extending rapid transit across the harbour.

More homes and jobs in our communities

Light Rail will help us create vibrant, compact centres where people choose to live, work and play close to home. With light rail at your doorstep, connecting to other parts of the rapid transit network, you can go from one area to another without relying on a car.

Future stations will form the heart of safer, more attractive town centres with new, quality homes, shops, businesses and neighbourhood facilities.

Revitalising communities and providing more quality homes means more people can afford to live in their existing neighbourhoods, reducing the need to develop on the edges of the city.

Community and stakeholder engagement will help to shape future decisions as the project progresses through the planning and design phase. This will include considering the location and design of stations, walking and cycling links and connecting with bus, ferry and rail services. The design will ensure stations are safe, comfortable and open to everyone.
